

ECUADOR: 8 people killed, 1,340 injured, 1,192 arrested, 3.11.2019 — HONG KONG: 2 people killed, thousands injured and more than 4500 people arrested in 6 months of uninterrupted protests, 23.11.2019 — RIF: On October 28, 2016, Mouhcine Fikri was crushed by a garbage truck in Alhucemas. Fikri was a street vendor. That day a wave of protests began. There are currently more than 450 Rifles imprisoned as a result of the protests. — CATALONIA: More than 600 injured, 4 people lost their sight after being hit by police rubber balls and foam bales, 213 people were detained and 28 were imprisoned. — CHILE: 200 eye mutilations, 24 people killed, 2000 injured, 192 men and women subjected to torture, 52 complaints of sexual violence. — Turkey launched the "Southern ROJAVA: In early October, Turkey launched the "Southern of Peace" offensive on northern Syria: 300,000 people were displaced, 11,000 dead and more than 24,000 wounded among the Kurdish people. — HAITI: From September 16 to October 17, the Haitian NGO Réseau National de Défense des Droits Humains (RNDDH) at least 35 deaths in the context of the protests, nine of which died at the hands of the police. During the same period, the NGO reported that more than 200 people had been injured. — ALGERIA: Thousands of protesters in Algiers and other Algerian cities. The day ended with 183 injured and a 56-year-old man killed by a heart attack. 45 people were detained. — SYRIA: Since the protests have continued since March 1, 2019, millions of people have been forced to flee their homes to save their lives. More than 5 million of them have escaped, according to the United Nations Refugee Agency (UNHCR). — LEBANON: Since the protests on October 17 against progressive taxes on digital social media services, as well as gas and tobacco, demonstrations have been blocking major streets in Beirut and other cities. More than 200 people have been detained. — COLOMBIA: Colombia went on a national strike in several cities around the country on November 21. On November 22 police action resulted in 100 arrests, 250 injuries and 3 deaths. — IRAQ: During the latest nationwide protests that broke out in October 2019, conflicts between the Iraqi security forces and protesters left 100 dead and more than 6,000 injured after the clashes. — FRANCE: 11 dead, 2500 protesters injured, 25 eye mutilations, 5 hands torn off, 3000 arrested...
